

ARBOR DAY POSTER CONTEST

Open to children in Grades 3 through 8. Children must be Grosse Pointe Shores' residents.

Entry Details:

Pick up a small, blank poster and entry card at the Administrative Offices, 795 Lakeshore Road, beginning March 1st, 2018.

Create a poster celebrating trees: their beauty, products, uses, etc.

Posters may be drawn using colored pencils, markers, paints, etc. Posters may be embellished in any way, such as by using additional colors of cardstock, fabric or felt, ribbon, cotton/balls, pompoms, Easter grass, pop sickle sticks, beads, glitter, etc. The poster may be cut, shaped, and/or extended beyond its edges, etc. Be creative!

Entries will be judged by a panel of GPS Tree Board members and other Village residents. A 1st place winner and a 2nd place runner-up will be chosen from each of three grade groups: grades 3-4, grades 5-6, and grades 7-8.

The (3) First Place winners will each receive a \$50 Visa gift card. The (3) Second Place runners-up will each receive a \$25 Visa gift card. The six winning entries will be included in the 2019 GPS calendar.

All of the posters entered in the contest will be on display at the Arbor Day Observance/ Fun Run on Sunday, May 6th. Following that, all posters will be displayed at the Municipal Building until the end of May.

To Enter: Return your completed poster and entry card, filled out and lightly taped to the back of the poster, to the Administration by **Friday**, **April 27**th. All entrants will receive special Arbor Day T-shirts!
